**My greatest strength is my caring personality and always having a positive attitude.*

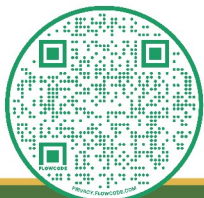
What do you like to do outside of school?
